Class Cuckoo Assembly

We ended last half-term with a fantastic assembly from Class Cuckoo based on their topic of the Romans. The play re-enacting the siege of Colchester with a flamboyant Queen Boudica and a lively group of Iceni warriors was most entertaining and helped the children understand the series of historical events and their cause and effect, and the final song pulled their learning together. Interwoven were snippets of how they had applied the skills taught in other subjects using the topic as a stimulus: the use of a computing programme to design and model Roman buildings was most impressive. Well done Class Cuckoo.

Pre-School Activity Morning

On Wednesday we hosted an activities morning for the Reception children and visitors from the local pre-schools. Mrs White and her team worked hard to set up a variety of activities including roadways, dinosaurs, puzzles, dressing up and role play. They were assisted by volunteers from Year 6 and I'm still not sure who had the most fun – the younger children, the older children or the adults. These events are a great way for pre-school children to visit a "big" school and for us to strengthen our links with the pre-school providers.





Barnardos Concert

On Tuesday a group of thirty Year 6 children accompanied by Miss Leaver, Mrs Ireland and Mrs Babbs went to the Albert Hall to join together with other schools and participate in a concert supporting Barnardos. The children and adults have been practising hard in school learning the songs and learning to play the ocarina. They rehearsed during the day and then performed to families and friends in the evening. I am pleased that we received excellent reports about our children not only their behaviour but also their attitude, application and enthusiasm. The children were particularly pleased that they broke the record for the most ocarinas being played at the same time and now have an entry in the Guinness Book of Records! Well done and thank you to all the adults and parents who supported us!

All the food will go to local people experiencing a crisis, whether that is the loss of an income, an unexpected bill on a low income, a relationship breakdown, debt or issues to do with benefits. It will ensure that less people go to bed hungry in our city."

Sadly the number of people needing the help of Chelmsford Foodbank has significantly risen. From opening in July 2012 until the end of March this year, they fed 869 people. Since the 1st April they have fed 1057 mouths. The need is, unfortunately, growing, and without your support they would struggle to be able to meet it.
