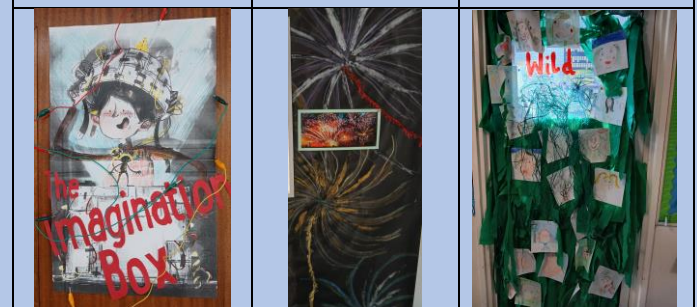
Let's hope this warm weather continues over the weekend.

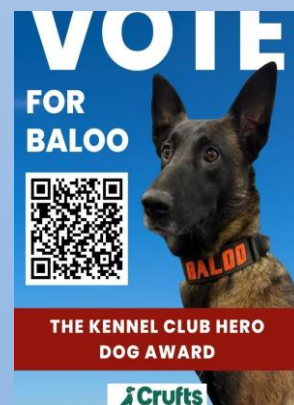
